- Thoughts or feelings of insecurity, fear, and concern over a relative lack of possessions or safety
- observed in infants as young as five months
- suspicious or reactive
- gender-based differences

Who?

- twice as many men as women reported having an extramarital affair
- stronger sexual interests, more permissive sexual values, lower subjective satisfaction with partner, weaker network ties to their partner, greater sexual opportunities


How common?
